REVUES ?

IMPERSONATOR SUES

Female impersonator Jim Bailey has filed a \$15 million libel suit against PEOPLE, a weekly magazine published by Time, Inc., claiming that the publication accused him of being a "drag queen, both in his personal life and in the course of his profession."

Bailey, a top nightclub draw with his impressions of Barbra Streissand, Judy Garland and others, said the story published in PEOPLE, September 30, was defamitory.

JACKIE RAPS TVs

Jackie Onassis was angry at the prostitutes that were parading up and down outside her ritzy apartment house on Ave Foch in Paris. She was even more upset when she found out that the ladies of the evening were actually guys in fancy drag.

In a letter to the police, Mrs. Onassis said, "I do not want prostitutes in front of my apartment building - but I will absolutely not not stand for transvestites being in the neighborhood."

LAOTIAN TVs

According to OUI Magazine, The American Women's Club of LAOS supplies Laotian men with their feminine frillies! The organization sponsors the "Ye Olde Thrift Shoppe", where the women sell their extra goodies.

Although most of the clothes are too big for the Laotian women (weighing on the average 91 1/2 lbss) they are just right for Laotian men. Every Saturday, the transvestite community gathers at the Thrift Shoppe, and then Saturday night finds them out soliciting in their new dresses.

TRANSEXUALS ARRESTED

Two male to female transexuals were arrested in Chicago and found guilty of wearing the clothes of another sex with the intent to conceal their sex. The arresting officer stated that he had seen one of the defendants in a bar two evenings before and had learned that she was a man there. Judge David Shields fined them each \$100 plus \$5 costs. Defense counsel Dan Schwartzman will appeal the verdict in the Illinois Appelate court.

QLF AT PRINCETON

Members of Queen's Liberation Front spoke recently at Princeton, N.J., following a lesbian-QLF rift at a New York rally.

Bebe Scarpie and Lee Brewster of QLF presented the case for the crossdresser, attacking gay elements which discriminate against the transvestite in the gay liberation movement.

Following the presentation by Scarpie, Brewster, and transexual Wilma Sharmin, the gays at Princeton issued a letter of support to the QLF.

This talk also marked the return of Lee Brewster, founder of QLF, to the speaking circuit after a two year absence.







TRANSEXUAL DIVORCED

Louis J. Davenport, a 54 year old New Jersey man, has recently won an annulment from his 24 year old wife, Brenda, on the grounds that he was unaware that she was a man and had undergone sex-change surgery. Davenport also charged that his wife was "not capable of having marital relations."

BENJAMIN IS 90

Dr. Harry Benjamin, one of the first experts on transsexualism recently celebrated his 90th birthday. With much opposition from within the medical profession, the doctor devised, in collaboration with sympathetic psychiatrists and surgeons, methods of treatment of transsexualism beginning with psychiatric evaluation and going on to hormone injections and sex change surgery.

Benjamin is also active in legal rights for transsexuals, concerning patients' new sexual identity on legal documents.

FEMALE TROUBLE

Devine, transvestite star of the movie, PINK FLAMINGOS, has recorded the title song from her new movie, FEMALE TROUBLES. She plays a dual role in the new movie; an auto mechanic and a woman.

PINK FLAMINGOS was made for \$10,000, and has grossed two million dollars to date. FEMALE TROUBLES cost \$30,000 and was released recently. It stars Devine, the 325 pound transvestite star, playing two roles, the lead character and her illicit lover.

NEW TS CASETTE

Kudos to Confide! The transvestite-transexual counselling agency has outdone themselves with the second casette in their series. Entitled, "Joanne's Story- The way of a Transexual," it is a very personal, candid look into the life of a person who has made the harrowing journey from male to female.

In a tactful, skilled interview with Confide director Garrett Oppenheim, Joanne talked freely about all aspects of her life- a life full of experience and wisdom.

Joanne has to be one of the most intelligent, sensitive women around, and her experiences serve as an education about the lifestyle of the transexual. This remarkable woman survived both heterosexual and homosexual marriages in an attempt to find herself. Her dealings with friends and business associates were surprising and humorous.

It is refreshing that after so many books have been published dealing with the "textbook transexual", we are at last given a look at a real person who, in this reviewers opinion, comes closer to a typical transexual, if there indeed is such a creature.

If you think that you might be a transexual, this tape is for you-you can compare your feeling to Joanne's and maybe come to some conclusion about yourself.

If you are already on your way, there is a lot of information about employers, insurance companies, and dealing with friends and relatives, which will come in handy along the way.

If you happen to be curious about what transexuals are like, by all means, buy this tape, and forget about the textbooks-you will learn far more in fifty minutes of listening than you will in hours of reading.

Beauty Bazaar

Like shiny hair and clear skin, beautiful eyes are another way of expressing your feminine personality. Long and luxurious eyelashes, especially, add to the beauty of your whole face.


False eyelashes are a quick and easy way to achieve this new look.

To put on false eyelashes, you should hold the lashes in tweezers and apply a hairline of adhesive along the edge of the lash band only. Look downwards slightly into a swivel mirror on a stand, hold the lash band above the eye level, and bring down towards the lid. Place the midpoint of the lash band above the center of the eye and press into position. The white adhesive will become colorless as it dries. Blend false and real lashes together for a natural look using a dry eyebrow brush.

Never mascara them to your own eyelashes. You're bound to pull a few of your own precious lashes out when removing the false ones and it isn't worth that!

To remove the lashes, take the outer corner of the lash band carefully between finger and thumb and gently pull.

False eyelashes can be curled by being wrapped around a pencil with a tissue and left overnight. ADD THICKNESS WITH FALSE LASHES














The time is the twenty-first century. In New York City, the worst fears of "future shock" have become daily realities. ARCHONISM

A New Philosophy Embraces The Problems of Transexuals by William L. Knaus Archonist Regent

The Archonist Club has extended socio-politico-philosophical inquiry to transexualism, and is contemplating political support for honest, rational, properly qualified transexuals. Archonist commentary has appeared in PENTHOUSE October 1972, and in PAGENT February 1974.

Archonism is ideology which advocates positive, vigorous, philosophically competent leadership, the proper self-preparation of citizens for responsible participation in civic affairs, maximum participation by prepared persons, and limitations on the influence of unprepared, unqualified persons. Archonism is also an active program of public enlightment against anarchy and against apathy.

Archonism is for the rational, aware, concerned individual. Archonist thought involves religion, science, history, and logic. Their concerns include domestic policies, foreign affairs, and the problems of persons. Their platform entails American disengagement from foreign entanglements of questionable merit, specific opposition to Zionism, to Israel, and to American support to and for Israel, stabilization of pollution, elimination of discrimination and harrasement of harmless transexuals, and a proper consideration of persons with unusual problems.

The Archonist organization includes "gynecopsyches" (would be women) whose interests are in women, not in men, and whose activities do not include overt, public dressing, at this point. Future strategy may involve some of these persons in dramatically political actions within some months.

In regards to transexualism, Archonist thought recognizes the complexity of the questions and the difficulty of the answers. Archonism does not suggest that genuinely benefical treatment be capriciously withheld from tormented persons; archonists merely insist that moral questions be duly considered, benefits be properly demonstrated, and that any program be properly constructed for maximum probability for success.

Morality, the archonists feel, dictates caution in programs dealing with human personalities; but the probably neuro-endocrinal causation of transexualism may suggest that clinical procedures are morally proper, that alternatives might not exist in some cases.

The archonists believe that evidence suggests that sociological factors may undermine logical and moral analysis, theoretical benefits and proper structuring of programs. In response, Archonist policy advocates continuing research, public enlightenment, and a decent regard for the problems of persons.

Fiction? Not really. Today, more and more docile males are finding fulfillment for their "slave" fetist under the charge of a cruel and lovely Transvestite. GAY SPIRIT A Guide to Becoming a Sensuous Homosexual. By David Loovis, Grove Press, 1975.

Within this thin, concise volume, there are all the little hints and pointers to help any gay man become a more sensous lover. The author touches briefly, yet completely on many of the subjectsof interest to gay men everywhere. There are ten exercises which Loovis recommends to help get in touch with one's own body. They're good, even if you feel funny doing them.

Logically, this is followed by a chapter on masturbation; the hows, whys, and why nots. This is followed by grooming hints, health, dress, and erotic role awareness, how to meet a frind for the evening, your gay personality, and how to drive your lover to ecstasy.

This latter chapter contains much of the sex manual type of information prevelant in most "how to be sensuous" books. However, the advice on positions, techniques, and sex roles are very badly needed in gay literature, and Loovis carries it off well.

The author stresses the importance ofverbal communication during sex, as well as lots of sound advice on helping a gay relationship endure. On the lighter side, some practical information is given on orgies, quickies, and drugs.

No matter how successful a lover you might think that you are, you cannot possibly finish this book without improving on your technique, learning how to please your partner, and being left with a sense ofpride about being homosexual.

JOURNAL OF HOMOSEXUALITY, Volume 1, No. 1

Although labelled as a journal of homosexuality, the scope of this professional is larger, and encompasses research concerning gender identity, sexual roles, transsexualism, and any other aspect of alternative lifestyle in addition to female and male homosexuality.

In the first issue are two articles dealing with transsexualism, one called, "Males, Females and Ttansexuals; A comparative study of sexual conservatism," by Thomas Kando, and one entitled, "Two Names, Two Wardrobes, Two person—alities," by Dr. John Money.

The Kando study is interesting in that it shows transexuals to adhere to sex role sterotypes more than do males — who tendo to support the sterotypes, and females — who tend to reject them the most. The author goes on to explore the reasons why, and talks about the social out come of the transexuals post—operatively.

The Money study points out the need to take time in evaluating trans—sexuals preoperatively to make sure the desire to change sex is genuine, and not the result of circumstances which may motivate the desire.

Although primarily a technical journal, the Journal of Homosexuality provides up to date empirical studies of the gay subculture. There are abstracts which condense and high—light each article in non—technical terms, making it easier for the non professional to understand.
